Inclusion of substances of very high concern in the Candidate List for eventual inclusion in Annex XIV

(Decision of the European Chemicals Agency)

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Whereas

- (1) Pursuant to Article 59(3) of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) the European Chemicals Agency (hereinafter referred to as 'The Agency') received from Member States one Annex XV dossier for a substance which in their opinion meets the criteria of substances of very high concern (SVHCs) set out in Article 57 of REACH.
- (2) On 01 March 2024, the Agency invited all interested parties to submit comments on the Annex XV dossier, as stated in Article 59(4) of REACH.
- (3) The interested party commenting period for the substance ended on 15 April 2024.
- (4) In accordance with Article 59(5) of REACH, the deadline for Member States or the Agency to comment on the identification of the substance as SVHC was 30 April 2024.
- (5) The Agency received comments on the identification as SVHC for the following substance:

- (6) Thus, pursuant to Article 59(7) of REACH the dossier related to this substance was referred to the Member State Committee (MSC).
- (7) The MSC at its 86th meeting agreed that ECHA should exceptionally suspend the process for the MSC to reach unanimous agreement on the SVHC identification of triphenyl phosphate. This suspension of the procedure ensured that newly provided data, submitted seven weeks after the expiry of the deadline for commenting on the Annex XV dossier, would be properly evaluated and considered in the SVHC identification process.
- (8) This suspension meant that the agreement seeking was moved to the next MSC meeting, i.e., MSC-87.
- (9) The MSC at its 87th meeting unanimously agreed that the following substance meets the criteria set out in Article 57 of REACH:

- (10) Therefore, this substance is identified as a substance of very high concern for the reasons set out in the relevant support document of this substance. Pursuant to Article 59(8) of REACH the Agency shall now include this substance in the Candidate List for eventual inclusion in Annex XIV to REACH.

I HAVE DECIDED THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The following substance is identified as a substance of very high concern meeting the criteria under Article 57 of REACH:**

Triphenyl phosphate	204-112-2	115-86-6	Endocrine disrupting properties (Article 57(f) - environment)

- 2. Under Articles 59(6) and 59(8) of REACH the substance referred to in paragraph 1 above with the indications provided therein shall be included in the Candidate List for eventual inclusion in Annex XIV to REACH.**

- 3. Pursuant to Article 59(10) of REACH the Agency shall on 07 November 2024 publish and update on its website the Candidate List for eventual inclusion in Annex XIV to REACH with the entry referred to in paragraph 1 above.**

4. Entry into effect

This decision shall take effect from 07 November 2024.
